


# Family Engagement Inventory

## Commonalities Across the Benefits Domain



The acronyms listed in the table indicate disciplines with similar benefits.

CW: Child Welfare

JJ: Juvenile Justice

BH: Behavioral Health

ED: Education

Similar benefits in all five disciplines	
Builds trust with families	CW, JJ, BH, ED, ECE
Promotes/improves well-being outcomes	CW, JJ, BH, ED, ECE
Promotes family buy-in for service provision	CW, JJ, BH, ED, ECE
Similar benefits in four disciplines	
Expands/improves planning options	CW, JJ, BH, ED
Improves the provision of needed services and the satisfaction with those services	CW, JJ, BH, ECE
Improves family members' ability to cope with issues	CW, JJ, BH, ECE

Reduces/decreases problem behaviors in children/youth	JJ, BH, ED, ECE

Similar benefits in two disciplines	
Improve community partnerships	JJ, ECE
Promotes safety and permanency/stability	CW, JJ
Reduces the possibility of recidivism/relapse	JJ, BH
Improves quality of programs and services	JJ, ECE
Allows families to be advocates and leaders (partners in policy and program and development):	BH, ECE
Improves educational outcomes for children and youth:	ED, ECE
Makes educational transitions smoother for children and youth	ED, ECE
Develops parents as lifelong educators	ED, ECE
